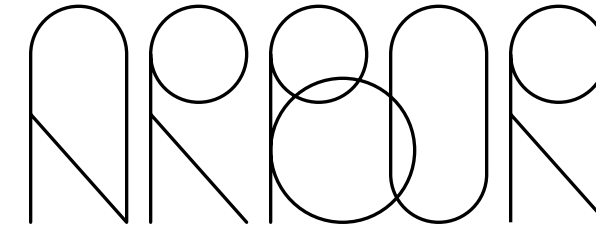

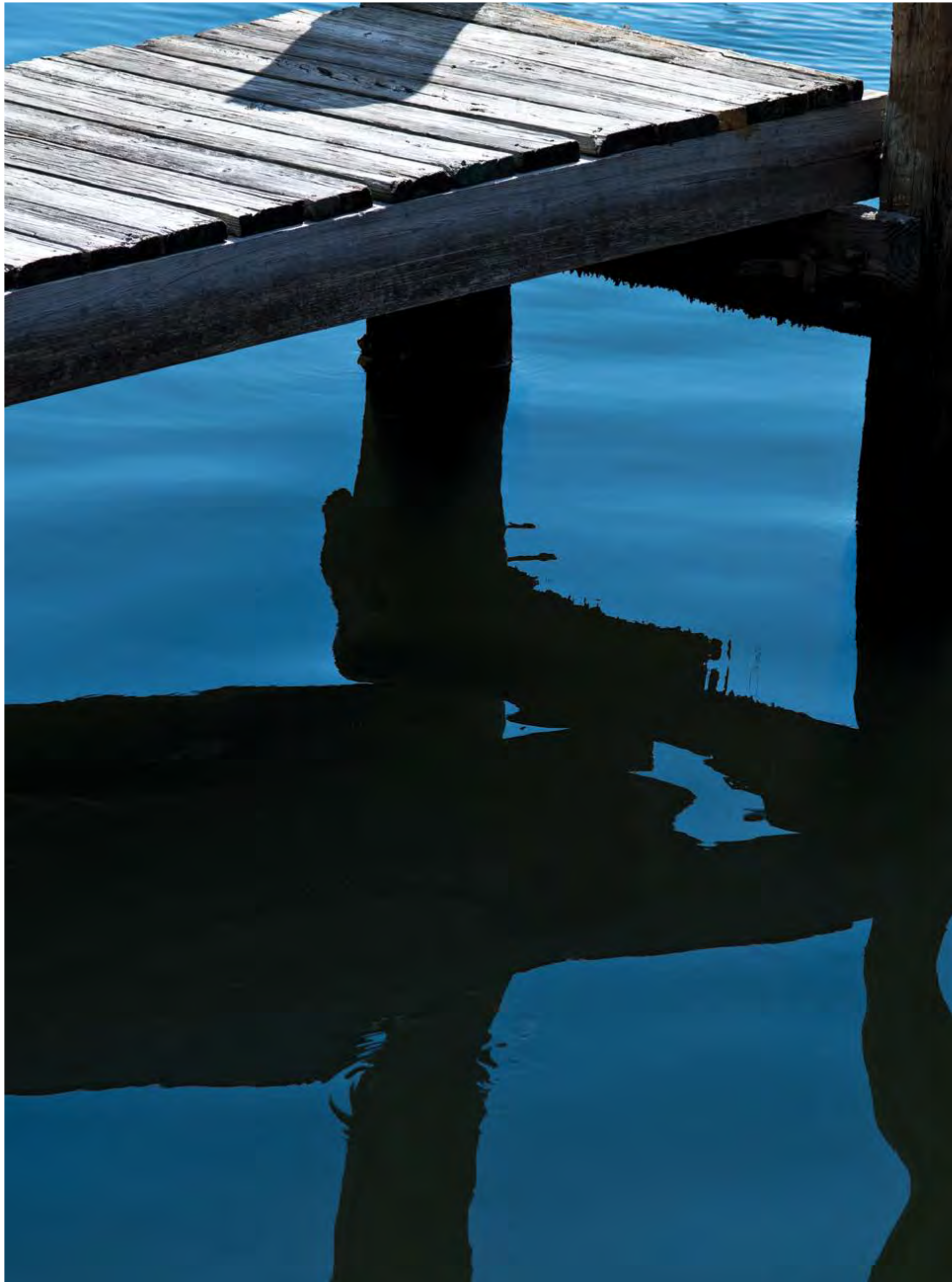


## Get Into the Grove

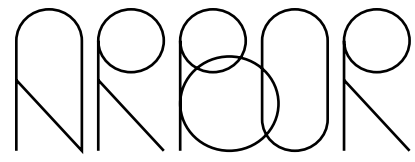


## Samuel Amoia Interior Designer
